

Chaos is not a generic and indeterminate mass of matter, but a constantly changing dimension in

which the speed of the emergence of new determinations leaves no space for the formation of

constant elements over time. What defines chaos, therefore, is the speed with which its endless

variabilities are exchanged with one another. Chaos serves, at the same time, as a creative source

from which creations originate and as a destructive force from which the same creations must

protect themselves. This project is an evolving sound sculpture made out of piece of wasted

materials: a motorcycle rim, chain and a bike gear. At its core, the project highlights the

integration of self-organized feedback system with low-power electronics into the realm of waste,

giving new life to neglected objects through sound.

The jungle becomes a living, breathing entity, and the music serves as a bridge between the natural world and fantasy which sometimes happens without human eyes. The piece is written in the style of «Musique Concrète». No processing. Only cut, paste and speed changing.

"pr_cncrt" is a very personal work about starting something. It plays with expectations and reduction. The combination of the latest multi-channel sound system with old tube amps is a reminiscence to the first musique concrete pieces and acousmatic music.

Cornelius Grömminger - Le Rituel / 05'30" – fixed media

This piece consists of a single 30-minute recording of a coffee preparation, which can only be recognized towards the end of the piece at the earliest due to the editing process. The audio material was edited exclusively by cutting, stretching, compressing and reversing, and is based on the working techniques of the Musique Concrète.

only existing record of her last concert. The file was irreversibly corrupted and this is a try to

regenerate with its remains, from my perspective, and as a reminder of the fragility of digital
