A preliminary time schedule for the entire duration of the 5 month visit is required as well as an intended dissemination strategy that ensures the publication of the achieved work, or a documentation thereof, in a suitable format. This could be done for example through the release of media, journal or conference publication, a project website or other means that help to preserve the knowledge gained through the residency and make it available to the public.
- Two examples from your artistic works (preferably as URLs or download links, downloads must not exceed a total of 100 MB).
- CV (English or German) and list of artworks and publications.
